Change in LCC Membership Fees for 2025



The LCC Board approved its 2025 budget this past fall. Due to increases in web hosting and newsletter server fees, insurance costs, and the desire to continue supporting local biking-related organizations such as Des Moines Street Collective and Bike Iowa, LCC membership fees have been modestly increased for 2025 as follows:

- For single memberships, the former fee of \$21 per year has been increased to \$25, an increase of \$4 per person
- For family memberships, the former fee of \$31 per year has been increased to \$40, which comes out to an increase of \$4.50 per person

It is the board's hope that these increases are understandable and affordable, and that your membership fee remains a good value for your biking in 2025.

Joining the Board in 2025 are:


- Tara Thomas is the new Treasurer of LCC, with her term ending December 2025.
